

# Poland Township Road Cut Worksheet

## Applicant

Applicant must make application at least 48 hours prior to the date of excavation or in event of an emergency as soon as possible.

## Bond

Applicant shall deposit with the Fiscal Officer as cash deposit in form of a check or surety bond \$2,000.00 or 15% of contract amount for excavation whichever is greater. The sum of \$200.00 shall be issued for each other permit. Bond shall be made to the Board of Trustees.

## Bond Release

Bond release shall be within 60 days upon satisfactorily completing the restoration of the road and approved by Inspector(s). If applicant fails to complete the restoration within 90 days bond shall be forfeited.

## Contractor Responsibilities

- Notify Utility Protection
- Install adequate warning signs
- Responsible to damage of roadway
- No off the road equipment with steel tires, treads or cleats permitted to be on public roadways without planking.
- Provide ingress and egress of driveways
- Before commencement of excavation of a closed or partially closed road applicant shall notify Police, Fire, EMS, School System and Post Office of location and completion date.
- If emergency work is required for burst, leaking pipe or similar problems an application must be filed within 2 days of the commencement of the work.

## Ohio Revised Code

No person shall make an excavation in any township highway in violation of any resolution adopted pursuant of Section 5571.16 of the Ohio Revised Code.

### Penalty:

Whoever violates section 5571.16 of the Revised Code shall be fined not more than two hundred dollars or imprisoned not more than thirty days, or both. (M-4)
